



BE AWARE OF PROTECTABLE ASSETS




Need to separate all elements of the project: the product, the process, the business model, the communication elements, the IT tools (programs and databases)...


Analytical effort to identify the different elements that can be protected and valued.



DATABASE & DATA: DIFFERENTS HOLD







GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULAT

- Protecting EU citizens from the processing of personal data and giving them maximum freedom over their digital information
- Applicable to any company that processes data of European citizens
 - -> company, administration, non-profit organisation, ...
- O Penalty: 4% of global turnover / €20m
- Entry into force: 25 May 2018

• Early warning and compliance in order to be eligible for funding, subsidies





WHAT IS PERSONAL DATA?



Any information relating to identifed or identifiable natural person directly or indirectly



private data professional data location, behaviour/consumption sensitive data identification by correlation

E.g.: name, online identifier, code, location data, etc.




WHAT IS DATA PROCESSING?





"Any operation or set of operations which may or may not be carried out by automatic means".


Examples: collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation, retrieval, matching, etc.















RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

- Right to information
- Right of access
- O Right to rectification
- Right to erasure ("right to be forgotten")
- O Right to limitation of processing
- O Right to data portability
- O Right to object
- Right not to be subject to a decision based exclusively on automated processing



CONDITIONS TO PROCESS PERSONAL DATA






CONTROLLER, PROCESSOR – OBLIGATIONS

- Developing and maintaining a record of activities
- O Risk analysis
 - O Description of operations
 - Necessity and proportionality
 - Technical and organisational measures
 - => Privacy by design and by default
- O Duty to inform (fairness principle)
- Ensuring data quality
- O Security

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- O Safeguards in case of outsourcing
- Appointment of a data protection officer (DPO)







PRIVACY NOTICE / PRIVACY POLICY: TRANSPARENCY TOOL

- Public document from an organization that explains how that organization processes personal data and how it applies data protection principles.
 - O In a concise, transparent, intelligible, and easily accessible form
 - Written in clear and plain language, particularly for any information addressed specifically to a child
 - O Delivered in a timely manner
 - O Provided free of charge



COOKIES AND TRACKERS



- Internet users must be informed and give their consent **prior** to the deposit and reading of certain trackers, while others are exempted from obtaining such consent.
- Regardless of the type of terminal used.
- O Consent exempted
- O Prior consent required
 - O Information of the user (purpose)
 - O Positive act of the user to accept or refuse
 - O Simplicity of the choice
 - Withdraw consent at any time



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


HOW TO MANAGE?

- O Data record
- Documentation and mapping on personal data processing
- Documentation and Data management plan
 - A document written at the beginning of a project that defines what researchers/developers will do with their data, during and after the project, making clear how the data will be made available
 - O Must be updated
 - e.g. WP in calls for proposals
 - O Mandatory for some research programmes







DATA MANAGEMENT PLAN

O Determine, at each stage, for each set of data:

- O Collection/creation of data
- O Production of documentation and metadata
- O Data quality
- O Data storage and backup
- O Data archiving & sharing



- Relevance and interest:
 - for the project itself, taking into account partners, third party rights (IPR, personal data, etc.) and the possible policy of the funding authority
 - O allows to determine the status of each 'layer' composing the research results (software, metadata, etc).
